

SUPPLIES and Discipline

Supplies Needed: Your student should have the following supplies for class:

- lined paper (Buy a lot. It's least expensive now in the stores!)
- red and blue ink pens (at least one package of 12 for each color)
- pencils
- highlighters
- 1 inch (3 ring binder) specifically for Social Studies The binder is used daily in our classroom and must be here EVERY DAY.
- one composition book for Language arts
- 2 spiral notebooks for Language arts (8" X 11" notebooks with at least 70 pages)
- colored pencils
- glue sticks
- NO SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS!!!!

Optional:

- scissors
- rulers
- markers
- **pencil sharpener** (one that catches it's own shavings)
- thesaurus and dictionary (sometimes found at the Dollar Tree)
