Ask them for a non-profit tax-ID or ask us in the Counseling Office. Hours that do not qualify will not be counted. This form must be turned in to the Counseling Office to complete the graduation requirement. **PLEASE SAVE/KEEP A COPY OF YOUR COMMUNITY SERVICE FORM FOR YOUR RECORDS.**
