What is WorkAbility I?

- WorkAbility I is a program which provides pre-employment skills training and follow-up services for youth in special education who are making the transition from school to work.
- WorkAbility I provides special education students (ages 16-22) the opportunity to complete their secondary education while also obtaining marketable job skills.
- WorkAbility I benefits the students, employers, and the community at large.

How Does The Program Benefit The Employer?

Employers Receive:

- Job ready workers anxious to learn.
- Screened applicants for training employment positions.
- Workers whose skills are assessed and interests matched with employer's needs.
- Training wages for some students.
- On-going employer support services.
