If you don’t know an answer to a question, you answer with the following:
“Sir/Ma’am, this cadet does not recall but will find out shortly Sir/Ma’am”

Addressing:

Non-Ranking Government Officials: Address them as “The Honorable ...”

Example: “The Honorable Joe Biden”

Sandwich responses with “Sir” or Ma’am”

Example: “Sir, The President of the United States is the Honorable Joe Biden, Sir”

When Reporting in, follow this format; [formalities], Cadet [rank] [name], reporting in for [event], sir

Example: “Good Morning sir, Cadet Airman First Class Johnson, reporting in for cadet of the month award, sir”
